

State Licensure Reciprocity Disclosure

The Salon Professional Academy will provide the program of study that meets minimum curriculum requirements as prescribed by the state of Colorado.

For states outside of Colorado: the institution has not made a determination on whether the program meets other states' educational/licensure requirements.

Information regarding other states requirements can be found at that state's web site.

The Salon Professional Academy does not provide training or activities out-of-state. All programs offered at the institution lead to professional licensure in the state of Colorado. All students, including those who live in bordering states, are notified prior to enrollment that education received at The Salon Professional Academy follows the Colorado DOPS requirements for and Cosmetology, Hairstylist, Barbers and Esthetics. Our program clock hours meet or exceed Colorado requirements and are as follows: Cosmetology 1800, Hairstylist 1200, Barber 1500, Esthetician 600, Nail Technician(Manicurist) 600.

The institution makes information available to students and applicants regarding the hour requirements in other states if requested and recommend that all applicants and students familiarize themselves with the comparison of other states' regulations and hours required for licensure, as applicable.

Additionally, the Transfer Policy indicates that "The Academy does not guarantee the transferability of its hours to any other institution unless it has written agreement on file of current acceptability of such hours from other institutions." Per the transfer policy on the website and in the catalog, our curriculum has not been reviewed for compliance with other states' professional licensure requirements.

The institution utilizes the Pivot Point Fundamentals curriculum for our programs, which is a nationally standardized curriculum through National Interstate Counsel (NIC).
